After a 25 year career in the insurance industry, Ms. Lovgren started Path to Resolution, LLC to provide arbitration, mediation, consulting, and expert witness services. She is a Florida Supreme Court certified mediator (circuit, county, and family) and qualified arbitrator. She serves as a mediator for the Florida Department of Financial Services Alternative Dispute Resolution Program and for Florida's Fifteenth and Seventeenth Judicial Circuit Alternative Dispute Resolution Offices. She also serves as an arbitrator for the American Arbitration Association, the Financial Industry Regulatory Authority, the Florida New Motor Vehicle Arbitration Board, and ARIAS-US. In the past two plus years, Ms. Lovgren has served as an arbitrator and/or mediator in more than 600 matters related to insurance and/or business. In addition, she has served as an expert witness in two workers compensation cases.

From 1999-2017, Ms. Lovgren held various legal and business positions with the National Council on Compensation Insurance (NCCI). NCCI is a licensed rating and statistical organization which provides services to workers compensation insurance companies and other system stakeholders in approximately 40 states. In addition to managing regulatory and legislative affairs in all states, Ms. Lovgren's responsibilities included managing disputes between employers and insurance carriers related to workers compensation rates, rules, and forms.

Prior to joining NCCI in 1999, Ms. Lovgren was an attorney with the law firm then known as Adorno & Zeder, P.A. based in South Florida. As part of the Insurance Transactional and Regulatory Group, Ms. Lovgren represented both health and property/casualty insurers on variety of matters including organization/formation of entities, corporate governance, licensing, insurance product development, regulatory filings, and examinations.

Her academic background includes a Juris Doctor from the University of Richmond (1991) and a Bachelor of Arts in Philosophy from the College of William and Mary (1987). She was also designated as a Chartered Property Casualty Underwriter (CPCU) in 2002 and earned an Associate in Data Analytics (AIDA) in 2019. Ms. Lovgren has been admitted to the practice of law in the District of Columbia (1993), Florida (1991), and Virginia (1993) and in various federal jurisdictions including the U.S. Supreme Court (1996).

She is a member of ARIAS-US, the CPCU Society, the Association of South Florida Mediators and Arbitrators, the Florida Academy of Professional Mediators, and the Broward County Bar Association. Ms. Lovgren has previously served as a CPCU Society Board Member, Governor, President of the Florida Gold Coast CPCU Chapter, and on the leadership team of the Regulatory and Legislative Interest Group. She is also a Past Chair of the American Bar Association Tort & Insurance Practice Section (ABA/TIPS) Workers Compensation Committee and a Past Vice Chair of the ABA/TIPS Insurance Regulation Committee. She has served as a Guardian ad Litem for abused and neglected children since 2007.
